and Acreage Dedication Plat

Gentlemen:

In compliance with Commission orders pertaining to gas proration in the defined gas pools, Lea County, New Mexico, we are submitting two copies of Form C-128 Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat for Gulf Oil Corporation's B. V. Culp "A" Lease Well No. 3, located in Section 19, Township 19 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. This gas well is producing from the Queen formation and is in the Eumont Gas Pool.

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission by Order No. R-1487 in Case No. 1683 approved a 477 acre non-standard gas proration unit to be attributed to Gulf's B. V. Culp "A" Well No. 3. This unit covers the N/2 and the SE/4 of Section 19, Township 19 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. This order stipulated that the effective date shall be the first day of the month following the month in which the Commission is notified that the subject well has been brought into balance. We are also attaching for your information, a copy of our letter of September 17, 1959, to the Commission's Santa Fe Office advising that this well will be in balance on approximately September 23, 1959, and requesting that the effective date of this unit be October 1, 1959.
