Gentlemen:

Reference is made to Order No. R-1487 in Case No. 1683, whereby the Commission approved a 477 acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool covering the N/2 and the SE/4 of Section 19, Township 19 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. The effective date of this order was stipulated as the first day of the month following the month in which the Commission is notified that the subject well has been brought into balance.

Permian Basin Pipeline Company, as purchaser of the Eumont gas from the B. V. Culp (NCT-A) Well No. 3, has advised us this date that this well will be in balance on approximately September 23, 1959; therefore, it is respectfully requested that the above described 477 acre non-standard gas proration unit be made effective as of October 1, 1959.
