This well was drilled to the total depth of 4020'. The 2 1/2" upset tubing was then run to 4000' and the well swabbed in. The well flowed 500 barrels of clean oil on 20 hour test. Flowing through 1" open choke on 2 1/2" tubing. Hourly average of 25 barrels. Daily gasrate of 350,000. Gas oil ratio 585.
