The Maxwell-State No. I was shut-in late in September, 1959 through October, 1959. The well was not capable of producing. A pump unit was added 11-10-59. The well tested 8 bopd on pump. A 1-1/4" sub-surface pump was set at 3600' using 3350' of 5/8" and 250' of 3/4" sucker rods.
