Kutter "B" No. 4, Forms C-104, C-110 and C-128 have been duly filed. Pending the furnishing to the Land Commissioner satisfactory evidence of communitization of Gulf's, Amerada's, Sinclair's and Great Western's acreage in the proposed 320-acre unit and approval of the unit by the Land Commissioner, Gulf desires to produce an 120-acre gas allowable all of which would be attributable to Gulf's 120-acre F. W. Kutter "B" Lease described as the S/2 and NW/4 NW/4 of Section 28, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
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- (6) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5 (b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
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- (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
 - (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
 - (e) By copy of this letter of application, all operators accruing interest in the section in which the proposed unit is located and all operators within 1,500 feet of the proposed unit well are notified by registered mail of the intent of Gulf Oil Corporation,

(3) The proposed non-standard gas production unit will meet the requirements of Rule 2 (b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. F-250 as follows:

- (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
- (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
- (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 2,280 feet.
- (e) By copy of this letter of application, all operators securing interest in the section in which the proposed unit is located and all operators within 1,500 feet of the proposed unit will be notified by registered mail of the intent of Gulf Oil Corporation,

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
