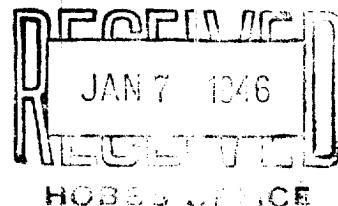

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Packer seal, previously reported November 21, 1945 and approved November 23, 1945, held satisfactorily for 27 days. On December 17, 1945 another seal was run with more material, composed of 100 pounds Seal Flake, 2 bales Fibrotex and 3 sacks of Aquagel. Halliburton pumps were used. Again seal was satisfactory shutting off most of upper gas.
