DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Acidized with 4000 gallons of 50% solution acid which went in hole under average pressure of 125 pounds. Acid was chased w/ 100 bbls oil and treatment required 2 hours and 8 minutes. Swabbed well into pits to clear up and then turned into tanks and in 4 hour test flowed 434 barrels of oil or an hourly average of 108 barrels. gas estimated 1,500 M. Before treatment well flowed 120 barrels of oil per day with gas estimated 500 M. Well went on schedule as of October 1, 1936.
