DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8-5/8" 28# 8-thd. New Electric Welded casing was set in this well at 2496' and cemented by the Halliburton Method with 500 sacks of cement.

Casing and fittings were tested with 1200# pump pressure and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. No drop in pressure resulted. Cement plug was then drilled out of casing and the same test again applied and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. No drop in pressure resulted. Drilling was then resumed.
