This well spudded May 30, 1936 and drilled to depth of 256' that date in redbed. G.B. Barnham, contractor.

May 31, 1936, 10-3/4" OD 40.50# SH LW casing was set at 255' and cemented with 200 sacks.

June 2, 1936, drilled plu and bailed 10-3/4" casing. After allowing to stand for two hours, bailer was run and hole found to be dry. Casing test OK.
