1 3/4" 40# 8-thd. New Lapweld casing was set in this well at 183' and cemented by the Halliburton Method with 200 sacks of cement.

Cement was drilled out of the casing and the hole bailed to bottom and allowed to stand undisturbed for one hour. The bailer was then run to bottom of hole to determine if any water had accumulated. No water had accumulated. The drilling was then resumed.
