11,019' Total Depth Granite, Ran Schlumberger Surveys, Electric, Dipmeter and Gamma Ray surveys, and placed a 10 sack cement plug from 10,935' to 10,932' and another 10 sacks cement plug from 10,375' to 10,343', another 30 sack cement plug at 5355' to 5265' and another 60 sack cement plug at 4050' to 3870'. Picked up drill pipe and found top of cement @ 3858' and drilled 5' cement and did not find any more cement until we reached 4030'. Recemented with 50 sacks El Toro Common cement and estimated fill is from 4030' to 3870'.
