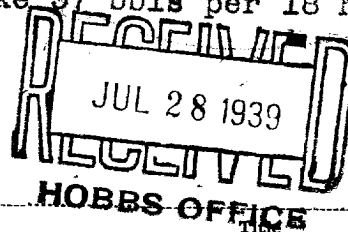

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Bordages #2 was treated with 3000 gal of non-emulsifying acid by Halliburton in July 18, 1939. Pump on tubing and casing both were used to control pressures so as to treat bottom 15' of well (3916-3931). Test after treatment indicated that well would make 57 bbls per 18 hrs.
