DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 11 jts (467') of 9-5/8" 36# J-55 SS casing. Set and cemented at 482' w/ 530 sacks Reg. Portland bulk neat cement. Max. Pressure 300#. Plug pumped to 440'. Cement circulated.

After waiting over 30 hours tested 9-5/8" casing w/1000# for 30 min. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement from 430' to 482' and tested cement below casing shoe w/300# for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.
