DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Treated well with 1000 gallons of Dowell X acid in lime formation from 3785' to 3880' through 2" tubing under 800# pressure. Flushed acid out of hole with 18 barrels oil. Swabbed well - failed to flow. Pulled 3784' of 2" tubing and re-run tubing & 3 Bryan Flow Valves. Well tested 20 barrels per hour on 4 hour test - 480 barrels per day. Tubing pressure 100# - Casing pressure 350#. Gas-oil ratio 529 to 1.
