
6. That applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.
7. That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasibly and practical.
8. That copies of this application have been sent to the operators of all leases directly or diagonally offsetting the said Laughlin Lease of applicant.
9. That the granting of this application for permission to dually complete this well prior to the time total depth is reached will allow the applicant to avoid needless and costly delays.

Therefore, Cities Service Oil Company respectfully requests that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission set a certain day upon which this application may be heard, and after said hearing to grant permission in order that applicant may dually complete its Laughlin No. 5 so that oil from Blinbry formation may be produced through the tubing and gas from the Queen-Seven Rivers maybe produced through the casing-tubing annulus.
