### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On March 8, 1952, 48 hours had elapsed since running 7349' of new 5 1/2" casing landed at 7365' and cemented with 200 sax of cement plus 4% gel and 200 cu. ft. of Perolite. 5 1/2" float collar was drilled out and casing tested with 1000 psi for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure occurred. Float shoe was not drilled. Tests were considered satisfactory and completion operations were resumed. Temperature survey indicated top of cement at 5960'.
