## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On February 4, 1950, at 2:30 A. M., 48 hours had elapsed since running and cementing 8-5/8" casing at 1609' with 1,000 sacks of 3% gel cement followed by 100 sacks of neat. Cement was circulated to surface. The casing was tested with 1,000 psi for 30 minutes before and after drilling the cement plug. No noticeable drop in pressure occurred during either test, thus indicating a satisfactory shut-off.

Drilling operations have been resumed.
