FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

At 12:00 Noon February 4, 1950, a total of 36 hours will have elapsed since cementing 8-5/8" surface casing at 1688' with 1100 sacks of cement. Cement circulated to surface.

Pipe and water shut-off will be tested with 1000 psi for 30 minutes. If the pressure drops more than 100 psi on either test, remedial measures will be performed. If tests are satisfactory, drilling will be resumed.

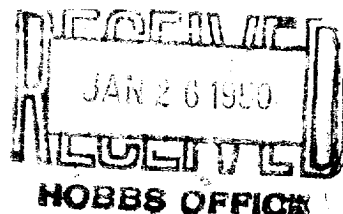

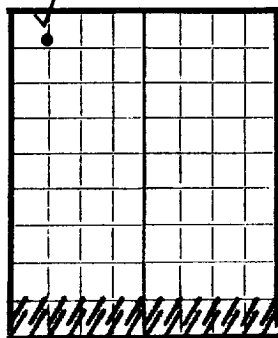
