FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Reference is made to Form C-101, Notice of Intention To Drill, filed by the Ohio Oil Co. and approved October 9, 1944 and Form C-102 Filed March 2, 1945 by Stanolind Oil and Gas Company and approved March 3, 1945 to drill and deepen test well at the above location. This well was to be drilled originally to a total depth of 7618' by the Ohio Oil Company. However, approval was received on Form C-102 filed by Stanolind and approved March 3d, to deepen this well to 10,200'. It has now been determined from present geological data that it will be necessary to drill this well to an approximate depth of 10,800' in order to satisfactorily test the lower formation.
