DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Perforations from 7160' to 7277' were squeezed with 50 sacks cement using Baker 3-B Model K retainer set 7113'. Cement was allowed to set for 24 hours, and then csg and cement tested with 1400# pressure for 1/2 hour, tested OK. Plug was drilled out and another csg test made to determine if perforations were closed successfully, tested OK. Csg was then perforated from 7180' to 7277' with 4 shots per foot.
