It should be signed and sworn to before a notary public for reports on beginning drilling operations, results of shooting well, results of test of water shut-off, result of abandonment of well, and other important operations, even though the work was witnessed by the State Geologist or Oil and Gas Inspector. Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public, but such operations should be witnessed by an Oil and Gas Inspector if possible.

Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the The Texas Company - H. D. McKinley Well No. 1 in the NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 4, T. 19S., R. 38 East, N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field, Lea County.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Condition of the well is as follows: Total depth 4185 Ft. 6-5/8" API 26# casing cemented with 200 sacks cement at 3960', 3" tubing bottomed at 4175 feet.

Well was treated with acid on April 18, 1934, as follows: 65 barrels of oil pumped into well through tubing followed with 2000 gallons of Dowell "X" acid. 40 barrel oil lead was used. Treatment was completed at 1:40 PM April 18, 1934 and the well shut in until 8:00 P.M. April 22, 1934. Well then produced until May 4, 1934 on which date the official proration gauge was made. The potential after acid treatment being 9,509 barrels of net oil per day as compared with potential before acid treatment of 6,185 barrels per day. Before acid treatment the well was making 3/10% BS&W. After acid treatment and on potential gauge the well made 28 1/2% BS&W.
