DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 3840 in line. Treated pay formations from 3762 to 3840 with 5000 gallons Dowell "XX" through tubing. Started swabbing 30 minutes after treating. Swabbed 9 hours. 162 bbl. acid & oil load. Shut in at midnight. 1000' pressure on casing next morning. Flowed 162 bbl. oil load in 24 hours. 1,100,000 gas. Next morning shut in from 7 AM to 5 PM. Opened 1 hour. Made 16 bbl. oil load & acid. Shut in to replace packer.
