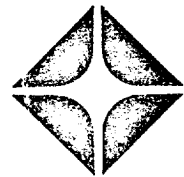



Dear Mr. Ramey:

Atlantic Richfield Company respectfully requests administrative approval to form a 40-acre Blinebry gas proration unit consisting of the SW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 36, T-21S, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico. This acreage will be dedicated to the State 367 No. 1 located 660' FS & WL of Section 36. Presently the well is classified as a dual Blinebry/Drinkard oil well. The Blinebry is shut in and an attempt is planned to recomplete in both Blinebry and Drinkard gas caps.

Atlantic Richfield believes approval of this request will protect correlative rights, promote conservation, and encourage the efficient recovery of gas reserves. Attached are an acreage dedication plat, a map of the area, and a list of offset operators who are being notified with a copy of this application.
