FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

The 7-5/8" casing was set at 4486' and cemented with 580 sacks 8% Gel and 100 sacks neat cement. On April 23, 1950 at 11:30 P. M., 48 hours will have elapsed since cementing the casing. At that time pipe and water shut-off will be tested with 1,000 psi for 30 minutes before and after drilling the cement in the shoe to 4484'.

In the event a satisfactory shut-off is not obtained, adequate remedial measures will be taken. If tests are satisfactory, completion operations will be commenced.
