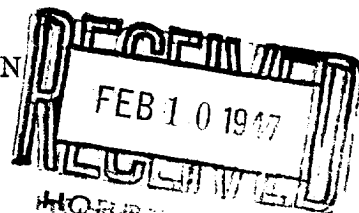

A copy will be returned to the sender on which will be given the approval, with any modifications considered advisable, or the rejection by the Commission or agent, of the plan submitted. The plan as approved should be followed, and work should not begin until approval is obtained. See additional instructions in the Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Permission is requested to plug and abandon the Continental State F-1-A #1 in the following manner:

Plug from the present total depth of 3900' into the 5 1/2" casing set at 3726'. Circulate well with 12 1/2 lb. mud and shoot off and pull the 5 1/2" casing. A cement plug will be set in the top of the casing left in the hole. Cement plug will be set through the base of salt at 3460' and the top of salt at 1805'. The 7 5/8" casing will be shot off and a cement plug set in the top of the casing left in the hole. A cement plug will be used to fill up the top 50' of the 10 3/4" surface casing.

Necessary marker will be erected and the location restored to its original condition.

Production has declined to the point where it is no longer economical to produce this well. It is not believed that further remedial work will increase production.
