Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant an exception to No-Flare Order R-553 insofar as it pertains to Gulf's J. F. Janda "K" Lease Wells Nos. 1, 2 and 3 which are located in the W/2 of Section 14, T-22-S, R-35-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Each of these three wells is completed in the Jalmat Poel. In support of this application, the following facts are furnished:

- J. F. Janda "K" Well No. 1 was completed February 2, 1958. This well was assigned an allewable of 33 barrels of oil per day for June, 1958, and the gas-oil ratio for June is 386 cubic feet per barrel.
- J. F. Janda "K" Well No. 2 was completed February 25, 1958. This well was assigned an allowable of 33 barrels of oil per day for June, 1958, and the gas-oil ratio for June is 682 cubic feet per barrel.
- J. F. Janda "K" Well No. 3 was completed April 10; 1958. This well was assigned an allowable of 33 barrels of oil per day for June, 1958, and the gas-oil ratio for June is 872 MCF per day.

The casinghead gas from these wells is centracted to Phillips Petroleum Company under contract dated April 2, 1958. It was necessary for Phillips to extend their gathering system to make connection, but because of undue delays in obtaining physical equipment for this purpose, Phillips will not be able to connect this gas until after the time

J. F. Janda "K" Well Me. 2 was completed February 25, 1958. This well was assigned an allowable of 33 barrels of eil per day fer June, 1958, and the gas-eil ratio for June is 682 cubic feet per barrel.

J. F. Janda "K" Well No. 3 was completed April 10; 1958. This well was assigned an allowable of 33 barrels of cil per day fer June, 1958, and the gas-oil ratio for June is 872 MCF per day.

The casinghead gas from these wells is contracted to Phillips Petreleum Company under contract dated April 2, 1958. It was necessary for Phillips to extend their gathering system to make connection, but because of undue delays in obtaining physical equipment for this purpose, Phillips will not be able to connect this gas until after the time

limit has expired for venting gas without approval.

In view of the foregoing information and in order to keep the wells on production and thereby protect correlative rights, it is requested that the Oil Conservation Commission issue an exception to its No-Flare Order R-553 thereby authorizing Gulf Oil Corporation to flare a combined volume of approximately 65 MCF per day from its J. F. Janda $^{\rm H}$ KH Lease Wells Nos. 1, 2 and 3. The estimated daily volume of gas to be flared from each well is as follows: Well No. 1 - 13 MCF, Well No. 2 - 23 MCF and Well No. 3 - 29 MCF.


