Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

Spudded 12-1/4 inch hole at 4:00 PM, March 19, 1957. Drilled to 295 feet in red beds. Ran 9 joints (280 feet) 8-5/8 inch O.D., 24-pound, J-55, seamless, 8 Rd thread, new casing with Texas Pattern shoe. Cemented casing at 292 feet with 150 sacks 1:1 cement and Halliburton Pozmix. Cement circulated. Plug down 1:00 AM, March 20. WOC 24 hours. Tested casing with 800 PSI for 30 minutes. No pressure loss. Drilled plug and drilled 7-7/8 inch hole ahead.
