Our application for 300 acre Non-Standard Gas Production Unit,
Salinas Gas Pool, Las Alamos County,
New Mexico

Gentlemen:

There is to request that the Oil Conservation Commission grant a 300 acre non-standard gas production unit embracing the NW 1/4 of Section 24 and the NE 1/4 of Section 25, T22N, R30E, Las Alamos County, New Mexico and the allowable to be assigned to the covered state oil gas well.

You will recall that by our letter dated July 18, 1929 we requested that the above be suspended and the assigned acreage for the above mentioned well be confined to 100 acres. Subsequent production has indicated that this well is capable of producing more than one unit allowable, therefore, we are requesting that it be returned to a 300 acre unit allowable.

In support of this request we wish to state the following:

1. The Corralito State No. 1, located 300' NW and 1000' SW of Section 24, T22N, R30E, has been completed as a gas well from within the vertical limits of the Salinas Gas Pool.
2. The proposed 300 acre non-standard gas production unit consists of the adjoining quarter sections which are no larger than 1,600' in any dimension and the entire unit area may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
