Drilled to a total depth of 3967'. Ran 124 joints of 5 1/2" O.D. casing. Total 3956.92' set at 3967.22'. Used 5 centralizers. B-J cmtd with 870 sacks of Diamix "A" with 1/2# of Flocele per sack and 200 sacks of Lone Star regular neat. Plug down at 10:50 A.M. 10-28-56 with 1500#. Released pressure. Hung casing on casing hanger. WOC. Worth Well Service ran temperature survey. Top of cement at 795'. Wellex ran GR-N log. Tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes. Test OK.
