Dear Mr. Porter:

In line with your letter of August 13, 1954, we are enclosing herewith Form C-103 for each string of casing set in the above captioned well.

This well was drilled to a total depth of 3840', encountering a small amount of gas along with considerable water. Several attempts to squeeze off, using a formation packer, failed to develop a producer. The hole was then plugged to the casing point with cement and lead wool, and the Seven Rivers section between 3736 to 3742 was tested by perforating the 7" casing and rendering acid treatment. Being unable to develop a producing well in the Seven Rivers section, the hole was then plugged, cementing from 3757' to 3682' with 15 sacks and filling the hole with mud laden fluid from 3682' to 1620' and with cement from 1620' back to 1570' and mud laden fluid back to 60' and the top 60' of hole filled with cement and marker set, in accordance with rules and regulations. This work was completed January 30, 1954.

We trust the foregoing information will complete your file in this respect; however, if additional information is needed, kindly advise.
