**FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK**  
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

This well currently produces by gas lift from the Queen sand formation. This well produces 11 barrel of oil and 7 barrel of water with a GOR of 10145. It is proposed to clean out to 3890', run radioactive logs, place permanent plug from total depth to the base of the sand section, acidize with 500 gallon of mud acid and swab to clean up, sand fracture open hole with 15,000 gallon of lease crude and 15,000 pounds of sand.

It is believed that this remedial work will increase oil from 11 BOPD to top allowable. A similar workover was completed recently on State "D" Well No. 1 and on a controlled test, it produced 511.29 barrel of oil, 1.6% BS & W, GOR 947, 32/64 choke. FTP 150#, FCP 420#.
