DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On October 23, 1952, at 6:10 P.M. 42 hours had elapsed since running 2882' of new 8 5/8" casing landed at 2893' and cemented with 300 sacks cement mixed with 4% gel plus 300 cu. ft. Perlite followed with 100 sacks neat cement. Top of cement by temperature survey was indicated at 1365'.

Casing shut off was tested with 1050 psi for 30 minutes before and 1100 psi for 30 minutes after drilling plug. There was no appreciable drop in pressure on either test, and drilling operations were resumed.
