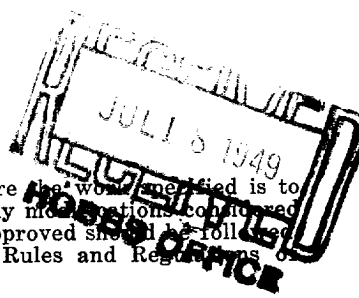

Originally completed on September 11, 1938. Total depth, 3791'.

Present production averaged 2 barrels of oil per day.

The subject well has been produced unprofitably for approximately 2 years pending the results of gas injection and possible deeper production. Gas injection was proved not feasible and injection was discontinued. The Alexander "B" No. 2 was deepened to 10,018' and deeper zones proved barren.

Authority is hereby requested for temporary abandonment in accordance with field and state regulations.
