At 6 PM Feb. 17, 1938, 72 hours had elapsed, at which time we ~~tested~~  
9 5/8" OD casing set at 1380' and cemented with 500 sax.

We conducted the test in the following manner: built up 1000#, closed valves and held for 30 minutes. Tested okay, drilled plug, built up 1000# pressure, held for 30 minutes after closing valves.
