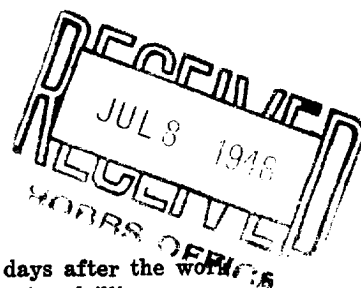

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 6676', lime. This well was acidized with 3500 gallons of acid on July 5, 1948. The well was swabbed and flowed an estimated 150 barrels of fluid to the pits. It was then turned into tanks and flowed 66 barrels of fluid, consisting of oil, BS and acid water, in 2 hours. During the next 5 hours it flowed at the rate of 25 barrels per hour
