Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the Continental Oil Company Mary K. Wanta Well No. 2-E in the 3W/4 Company or Operator Lease of Sec. 21, T. 21-S, R. 37-E, N. M. P. M., Brunson Field, Lea County.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Subject well was drilled to 2,730' in lime and anhydrite. On 9-16-49 set 9-5/8" OD casing at 2,729' and cemented with 650 sacks, using 3 centralizers. After cement had set 48 hours, found 32' cement inside 9-5/8" casing. Tested for 30 minutes with 1200 p.s.i. pressure, drilled plug to 2,730' and tested for 30 minutes with 1200 p.s.i. pressure. No drop in pressure.
