RE: Plugging Reports

Gentlemen:

Form C-102, Notice of Intention to Plug, your State A-32 #5-J 32-22-36
Lease Well No. Unit S-T-R
was approved on 3/8/62. Your final plugging report, which has been filed
on Form C-103, cannot be approved until a commission representative has made an
inspection of the location to see:

- (1) all pits have been filled and levelled;
- (2) a steel marker, 4" in diameter and approximately 4' above mean ground level, must be set in concrete, this marker must have the quarter-quarter section or unit designation, section, township, range numbers, which shall be permanently stenciled or welded on the marker;
- (3) the location shall be cleared & cleaned of all junk;
- (4) the dead man wires must be cut.

The above are the minimum requirements.
