DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After drilling an 8 3/4" hole to a depth of 3075' from the derrick floor, 7" O. D. 23#, J-55 new casing was cemented at 3074.99' with 750 sacks of Trinity Inferno bulk cement. After waiting 48 hours for the cement to harden, the casing was tested with 1000# for 30 minutes. There was no drop in the pressure.
