

4. The amount of gas presently being flared daily is approximately 24 MCF from #41, 18 MCF from #42, and 15 MCF from #43.
5. Efforts have been made and are being made to connect the wells in question to a gathering system. (See attached letter of El Paso Natural Gas Company).
6. The attached plat shows the location of the wells in question and offset ownership.

To keep these wells on production, permission is requested to flare gas in the amount of approximately 24 MCFPD from #41, 18 MCFPD from #42, and 15 MCFPD from #43; until such time that a connection can be made to a gathering system.
