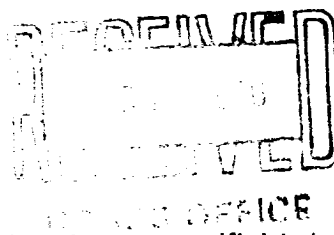

Preparing to acidize 2000 gallons from 3650 to 3580'. Seal bottom of hole from 3580' to plug back total depth 3609' w/sand. Treat zone above 3580', if formation takes acid satisfactory use 2000 gallons. If injection difficult, use 1000 gallons and replace on production w/flow valves. Gamma Ray Survey.
