DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On January 7, 1947, perforations from 6520-88 were acidized with 5000 gallons of 15% acid. On January 30, 1947, subject well flowed 51.28 BO plus 13.63 BW through open 2" tubing in two hours. Gas-Oil ratio was 1131 cu. ft. per barrel. Well flows three or four hours then dies, but can be kicked off again next day. We propose to flow well by "Stop-cocking."
