Permission is hereby requested to install flow valves and connect outside gas for gas lift at our R. Brunson #1. The outside gas will be from the Eunice Gas System. The Eunice Gas System receives gas from W. A. Ramsay #1 gas well, which produces from the Yates and Seven Rivers formations; and from our H. T. Mattern #1 gas well, which produces from the Queen and Grayburg formations. The W. A. Ramsay #1 gas well is located in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 34, Twp. 21S, Rgs. 37E. The H. T. Mattern #1 gas well is located in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 24, Twp. 21S, Rgs. 36E.
