

Gentlemen:

The Samedan Oil Corporation respectfully requests the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to issue approval authorizing the dual completion of its J. O. Parks Well No. 2 located 4 1/2 miles North of the South Line and 520 feet East of the West Line of Section 17, T. 32, R. 27, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Blueberry formation and the Brinkard formation and wishes to state the following in support thereof.

- (1) The subject well was completed as an oil well in the Brinkard formation on January 1, 1953.
- (2) The Samedan Oil Corporation has agreed to complete the subject well in the Blueberry formation, as a gas well, and states that with modern techniques and equipment, it is both practical and economical to simultaneously complete the subject well in a manner such that there will be no communication of fluids between the oil and gas reservoirs.
- (3) The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of the subject well and the 160 acre unit developed for oil and allowable purposes.
- (4) The attached Exhibit "B" shows the name; and method of the dual completion.
- (5) The approval of this application is requested; interest of conservation and the protection of mineral rights, and the Samedan Oil Corporation will comply with all rules and regulations to maintain separate oil and gas production from the two pay zones.
- (6) A copy of this application is being forwarded to each offset operator.
