The Samadan Oil Corporation respectfully requests the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to issue approval authorizing the dual completion of its J. O. Parks Well No. 2 located 4.9 feet North of the South Line and 520 feet East of the West Line of Section 12, T. 22N., R. 17E., Lea County, New Mexico in the Blinobry formation and the Brinkard formation and wishes to state the following in support thereof.

- (1) The subject well was completed as an oil well in the Brinkard formation on January 2, 1953.
- (2) The Samadan Oil Corporation desires to complete the subject well in the Blinobry formation as a gas well, and states that with modern techniques and equipment, it is both practical and economical to so dually complete the subject well in a manner such that there will be no contact of fluids between the oil and gas reservoirs.
- (3) The attached Exhibit 'A' shows the location of the subject well and the 160 acre unit designated for the allowable purposes.
