DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6482' Plugged Back Depth. Acidized with 1000 gals. Western 15% Low Tension Acid. At 2:35PM 9-10-48 had slight formation break 2500# - 2000# with 2 bbls. acid in formation. Oil flush of 24 bbls. complete at 3:20PM with 24 bbls. acid in formation, 2725# on tubing. Turned to tanks 3:30PM. In 14 1/2 hrs. to 6:00AM, 9-11-48, well flowed and swabbed total of 174.57 bbls. fluid, 11.5% water, 5% gas. Well making gas by heads. In 31hrs. to 1PM, 9-12-48, swabbed 106.95 bbls. fluid, 30% water, gas decreasing, pulling swab from bottom. Pulled tubing and packer and reperforated 5 1/2" casing 6445'-6450', 20 shots.
