DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A caliper survey was made of hole to determine size of ~~max~~ cavity caused by shot between depths of 3530' and 3694'.

Computations based upon findings from caliper survey indicated that 460 sacks would fill shot cavity. Hole was, therefore, cemented with 300 sacks of 2% aquagel cement and 200 sacks of neat cement. Drill pipe was raised to depth of 3498' and all cement above this point was circulated out of hole. Job completed at 5 P.M. October 3, 1946.
