FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This test was drilled to depth of 3694', in 1938, by Olean Petroleum Company. Casing run in this test; as shown by records in the New Mexico Conservation Commission Office; is as follows: 40# 10-3/4" 10 thread cemented at 147' with 65 sacks; 28# 8-5/8", 8 thrd., casing cemented at 1119.3' with 150 sacks; 24# 7" O.D. 10 thread casing cemented at 3367' with 175 sacks. Hole shot with 500 quarts S. H.G. from 3530' to 3694'.

We propose to deepen this hole to a depth of approximately 6425'; run 5" O.D. casing to bottom and cement with sufficient cement to bring returns above the shot hole. The casing will then be gun-perforated opposite the pay section and the well completed.
