Gentlemen:

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By this letter of application, Western Oil Fields, Inc.,
wishes to state the following:

(a) That the Western Oil Fields, Inc., Drinkard
No. 4, located in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 25, Township 22 S,
Range 37 E, was completed in August, 1953, as a Drinkard oil
well, total depth 7160'. The attached "Exhibit A" shows the
location of this well on the Drinkard lease, together with
the location of all offset wells.

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(b) That subject well has 5-1/2" casing set at
6976', and is producing from open hole, 6976' - 7160', oil
from the Drinkard (Andrews) zone.

(c) That the applicant proposes to dually complete
the well in the following manner:

(1) Perforate the 5-1/2" casing within the
interval of 5440' - 5480', in the Bline-
bry Gas Pay.

(2) Set production type packer below these
perforations at 6900' to separate the two
pay zones.

(3) Produce the Drinkard oil through the tubing
and Blinebry gas through the tubing-casing
annulus.

(d) That the granting of this application for per-
mission to produce the well as a dual completion is in the
interest of conservation and the protection of correlative
rights.

(e) That the applicant will comply with all rules
and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission
to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.

(a) That the Western Oil Fields, Inc., P.O. Box 871,
Santa Fe, New Mexico, is located in the Santa Fe County, New Mexico,
and was completed in 1953, as a horizontal well,
well, total depth 7160'. The reported "Exhibit A" shows the
location of this well on the P.O. Box 871, Santa Fe, New Mexico,
the location of all other wells.

(b) That subject well has 2-1/2" casing set at
8000', and is producing from two holes, 8000' - 7160', and
from the P.O. Box 871, Santa Fe, New Mexico, zone.

(c) That the application proposes to drill complete
one well in the following manner:
(1) Horizontal, 2-1/2" casing with the
interval of 8000' - 7160', to the lower
pay zone.

(2) Set production pipe packer below zone
formation at 7000' to separate the two
pay zones.

(3) Produce the well in all through the casing
and allow gas to flow through the main - water
separator.

(4) That the setting of this application now pro-
posed to produce the well as a dual completion is to be
increased to conservation and the production of complete
results.

(5) That the applicant will comply with all rules
and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission
to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.

(f) That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.

(g) That by copy of this letter of application, all offset operators are notified of the proposed dual completion.

(h) That this well is within the area limits of the Blinebry Gas Pool.

Therefore, Western Oil Fields, Inc., requests that the Commission grant permission to the applicant to dually complete the subject well as proposed in this application.
