DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Plugged back with cement from 3706' to 3606'. Cement pumped in through tubing by Halliburton method. Hole filled with heavy mud to 1250' and cement plug spotted between 1250' to 1150'. Ran cellar buster and recovered 898' of 8-5/8" casing, leaving 330' in hole. Knocked off 10-3/4" casing and recovered 775', leaving 22' in hole. Shot off 12-1/8" casing with 8 sticks of dynamite and recovered 63', leaving 300' in hole. Hole filled to surface with heavy mud and capped with cement. Location marked by short joint of 6" pipe set in cement cap.
