#### DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill an exploratory well with rotary tools at above location to an approximate TD of 4300'. Casing will be cemented in accordance with U.S.G.S. standards and other special requirements will be complied with.

The following casing pattern is planned: 10 3/4" OD set at 925' with 350 sacks cement, cement to be circulated to surface; 7" OD casing set at 4300' with 1,000 sacks cement. Depths and number of sacks of cement are approximate. Exact amount of cement will be determined by caliper survey.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

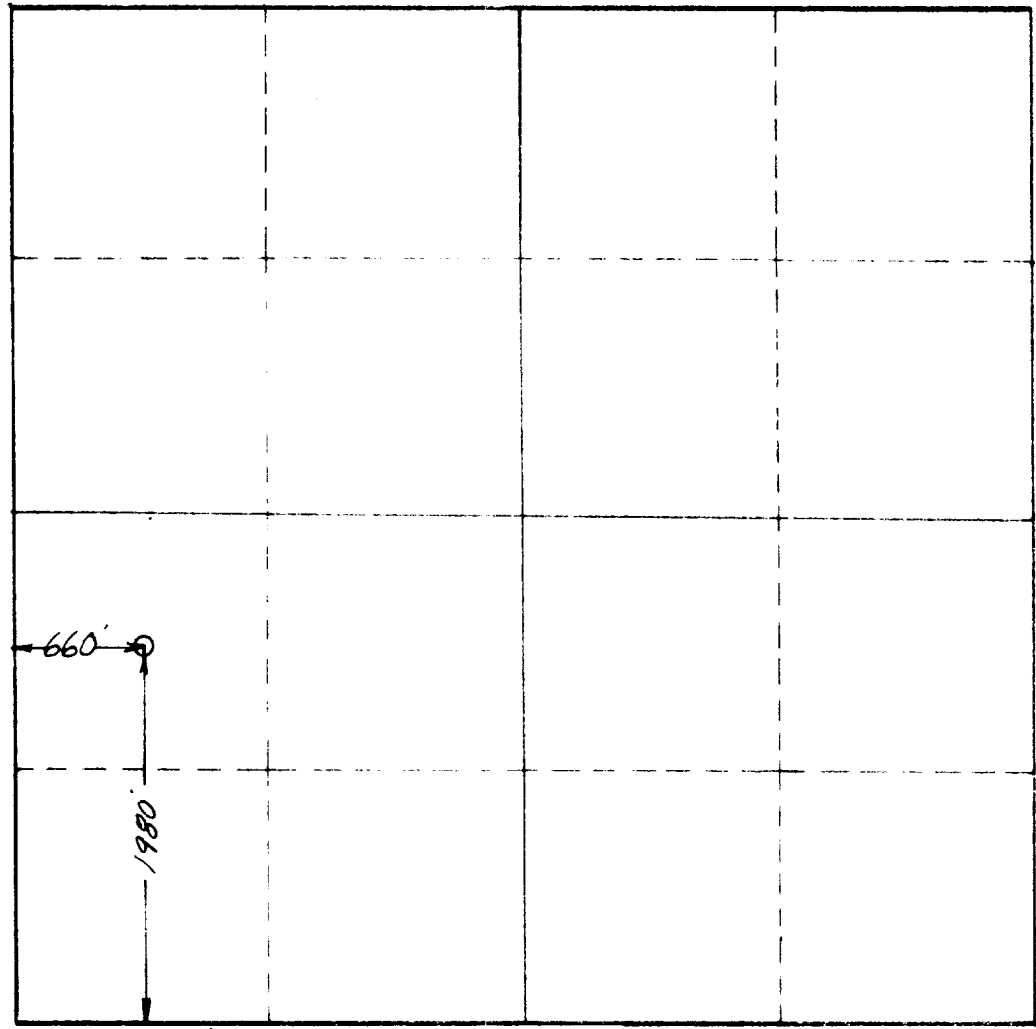
